

CHAD'S CORNER

WEDNESDAY EVENING

The Lord's Prayer Doxology

This morning I am concluding our series on the Lord's Prayer from Matthew chapter 6 by looking at the doxology, "For Thine is the Kingdom, and the power and the glory for ever. Amen" (6:13b, KJV). This was most likely not original to Matthew but was later added to the manuscripts around 130AD. The dictionary defines *doxology* as "an expression of praise to God, especially a short hymn sung as a part of a Christians worship service." The word itself comes from two Greek words: *doxa* ("glory, splendor, grandeur") and *logos* ("word" or "speaking"). There are many examples of doxologies in the Bible (Romans 8:38-39, 11:33,36, 16:5-6, 13; 1 Corinthians 15:58; 2 Corinthians 13:11,14; Galatians 6:18; Ephesians 3:17-21, 6:23-24; Philippians 4:7; 1 Timothy 6:15-16; Jude 24-25; Revelation 5:12-13, 22:20-21, and many more I could list).

Even if this doxology was not a part of Jesus' original teaching in Matthew 6, the phrase itself is from Scripture found in a prayer of King David: "O LORD, the God of our ancestor Israel, may you be praised **forever and ever**! Yours, O LORD, is the greatness, the **power**, the glory, the victory, and the majesty. Everything in the heavens and on earth is yours, O LORD, and this is your kingdom. We adore you as the one who is over all things" (1 Chronicles 29:10-11, NLT). So, in this final message, we will look at the Who, What, How, and Why of The Lord's Prayer Doxology.
