Some examples that may come to mind for many are events like the Black Death of the 1300s, the Fall of Constantinople or the invention of the Gutenberg Printing Press in the 1400s, the Protestant Reformation in the years 1517-1750, our own Civil War in the 1800s, and there are many more we could list. *Jesus said... "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die;" John 11:25 (NIV)*
